Hundreds of dogs roam the streets of Agua Prieta. These animals are exposed to the elements, to hunger, thirst, abuse and injury. Those that are ill suffer greatly.

In 2005, Rancho Feliz volunteer Kim Kroger, established the Mexico Mutts Program to reduce the suffering of these neglected dogs. Spay/neuter clinics, humane euthanasia and pet-care education are the Program's focus. But, there was no place to house and care for discarded strays.

In 2015, Rancho Feliz, partnered with SOPROANI, Agua Prieta's local dog shelter. Volunteers plant trees for shade, socialize dogs, and fund dog food donations.

Volunteering at our Mexico Mutts Animal Shelter is now one of our most "in-demand" and rewarding "Exchange Experiences."
