## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

# WHY IS THIS A "PARTNERSHIP" FUNDING REQUEST?

Rancho Feliz is a grassroots organization **VOLUNTEERING** since 1987 in the struggling border community of Agua Prieta, Mexico (population 150,000 and a 4 hour drive south of Scottsdale, Arizona).

Over the decades we have nurtured enduring cross-cultural relationships that allow us to operate efficiently in a complex international setting. We have one agenda – to leverage our time and donations for the greatest global good.

What if you could partner with a proven group of determined volunteers and donors?

Your funds - partnered with our funds, time, energy, passion and a lifetime of experience.

#### **HISTORY**

Experience has taught us that the single largest return on our charitable investment is **EDUCATION**. And the best education is a carefully composed curriculum emphasizing English and computer skills taught by well-trained teachers.

## **OUT OF REACH**

Unfortunately, the average factory wage in Agua Prieta hovers around \$10 per day - \$3,000 per year. Yet the cost of goods is 80% of ours here in Scottsdale. Most students and their families simply cannot afford quality education. And once a child's schooling is compromised his or her fate is sealed. High drop-out rates, illiteracy and grinding poverty breed a life of hopelessness. Drugs, prostitution and illegal immigration flourish in this garden of despair.

#### **SOLUTION**

In 1999 Rancho Feliz established a "Culture of Education" by building a visionary 3½-acre residential community commonly referred to as "Vecinos". Here children are educated from 40-days of age at our on-site Child Care Facility. In addition, Rancho Feliz formed an educational alliance with two private bi-lingual schools: Colegio Americano Anais, for grades kindergarten, elementary and junior high and Colegio Benemerito de Las Americas for high school.

#### **SCHOLARSHIPS**

To fund these private educations\* Rancho Feliz established the "Guardian Warrior" Private Scholarship Sponsor Program. This Program averages 65 students per year. And the results are unprecedented. All Vecinos children now speak English and conduct their schoolwork on computers.

\*Rancho Feliz also sponsors approximately 200 public high school scholarships per year. This effort is known as the Barrio Scholarship Program.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Rancho Feliz does not believe in, nor practice, welfare. To acquire and maintain a Rancho Feliz scholarship requires, among other responsibilities: initial and yearly essay applications, minimum grade point averages, monthly volunteer work, parental/guardian financial statements, parental/guardian co-pay and active student solicitation of supplemental scholarships. It is important to Rancho Feliz that both the student and his or her parents/guardians are personally invested in the child's education.

#### **UNIVERSITY - A DREAM NEVER THOUGHT POSSIBLE**

Over the last decade Rancho Feliz's scholarship programs have been so successful that many students are now graduating high school eager to enter university. For most this is a dream never thought possible. Accordingly, Rancho Feliz has established the:

RANCHO FELIZ "GUARDIAN WARRIOR" UNIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIP SPONSOR PROGRAM

Rancho Feliz encourages its scholarship students to study in their home country of Mexico. In this way, future generations can help Mexico transition from a third world country into a first world country - providing educational and employment opportunities for all its citizens.

#### STATE UNIVERSITIES IN MEXICO

The educational quality of state universities in Mexico is recognized as high. Accordingly, Rancho Feliz offers scholarships to any state sponsored university in the country of Mexico. There are over 80 such universities available to Rancho Feliz "Guardian Warrior" University Scholarship students.

#### MINIMUM GRADE POINT

Academic grading in Mexico employs a decimal system, from 0 to 10, to measure the students' scores. (1 low - 10 high) A minimum grade point of 8.0 is required to be eligible for and to maintain a Rancho Feliz "Guardian Warrior" University Scholarship.

#### **RENEWAL**

Once a student is accepted into the Program they need to re-apply each year. However, all scholarships are reviewed on a per semester basis. In this way the students' grades are monitored allowing for responsive intervention should problems arise.

## PARENTAL CO-PAY AGREEMENT (Cross-Border Partners in Education)

Rancho Feliz does not believe in welfare. Accordingly, each family must sign a Parental Co-Payment Agreement and contribute \$30 per month towards their child's tuition. In the Agua Prieta economy this is a significant contribution. And while monetarily it's not much to Rancho Feliz, it's the concept of contribution that the charity is promoting. This is not a hand-out. Parents are investing in the education of their children.

**NOTE:** Working between USA dollars ("dollars") and MX pesos ("pesos") is a challenge. We collect from sponsors in dollars and collect the parental co-pay amounts in pesos. The exchange rate between these two currencies can adjust daily – sometimes hourly. In an effort to be fair, Rancho Feliz uses a five (5) year "look back" to establish an average exchange rate over that period of time. The year the scholarship is issued (all scholarships are issued only one year at a time), will determine the "look back" exchange rate and the monthly peso amounts due for that year. Because of the fluctuating currencies, the monthly peso amounts will change with each new year. But by using a 5-year average there should be no dramatic annual increases or reductions.

#### **PAYING IT FORWARD**

Rancho Feliz believes that education is the only viable solution to the poverty and economic inequity that cripples Mexico. An educated populace can demand transparency, accountability and opportunity. To further achieve this vision, each scholarship recipient must agree in writing to fund a 7-year, public high school and university curriculum for an upcoming deserving student. This "Pay it Forward" obligation totals \$2,260.00US and can be paid in full, or in installments, within 4 years of graduation.

Many students in the USA graduate owing student loans. The "Pay if Forward" commitment is viewed as the Rancho Feliz equivalent. So when you fund a Rancho Feliz "Guardian Warrior" University Scholarship you set in motion an educational ripple effect. Your gift will keep on educating for countless generations to come.
